Please do not transmit until requested. I will be using the Alachua County Simplex Test Data Form to call out transmitting stations in the order given.

When requested, transmit for 30 seconds on 146.550 giving your name, call sign and approximate location. Please speak slowly. When finished contact the test controller on the 146.820 repeater.

All those who are listening please use the Alachua County Simplex Test Data Form. If you do not have a Data Form, record the call sign and readability of the signal on all stations that you have heard. Monitor the repeater to record who will be transmitting next.

(Break)

This is simplex test control. Station (insert 1st station here) begin transmitting

After last transmitting station from list is complete and time permits read the following;

If anyone else would like to transmit then contact the test controller via the repeater. Volunteers will have 30 seconds to transmit on 146.550 simplex. When your 30 seconds is complete, contact the test controller via the repeater. Volunteer transmitters please call now.
